It was a very special day in many ways at Cabrini of Westchester! Missionary Sisters from several New York City communities joined with those at St. Cabrini Nursing Home, along with residents, staff, volunteers and Cabrini Lay Missionaries in celebrating the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 3rd.

At the liturgical celebration of the Eucharist, offered by Rev. Edwin Robinson, OFM, Director of Pastoral Care, and following the homily, the Missionary Sisters, led by Sister Arlene

VanDusen, MSC made a devotional renewal of their vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. All present joined in the congregational response, thanking the sisters for their fidelity and love and promising them their support.

Next, Pat Krasnausky, CLM Director, invited Lorraine Campanelli and Melanie Paccillo to come forward to enter into their commitment, as Cabrini Lay Missionaries to pledge themselves to the mission of Jesus and to be bearers of his love in the world. 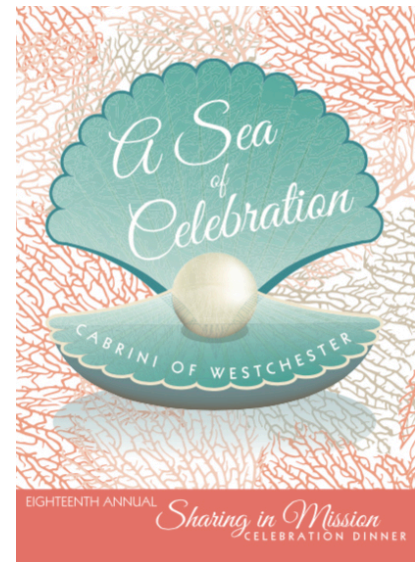

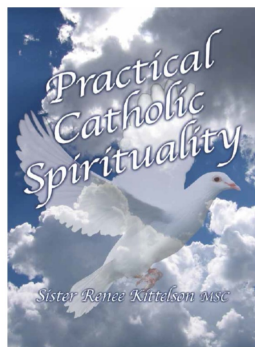

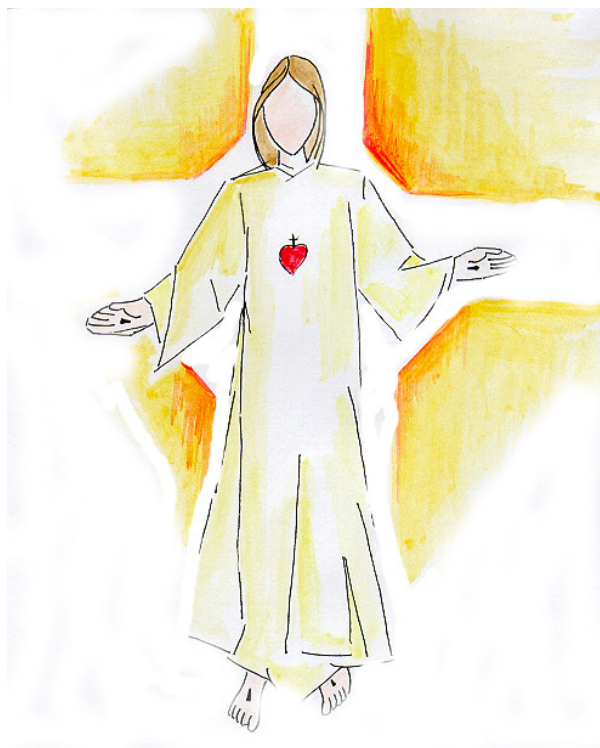
