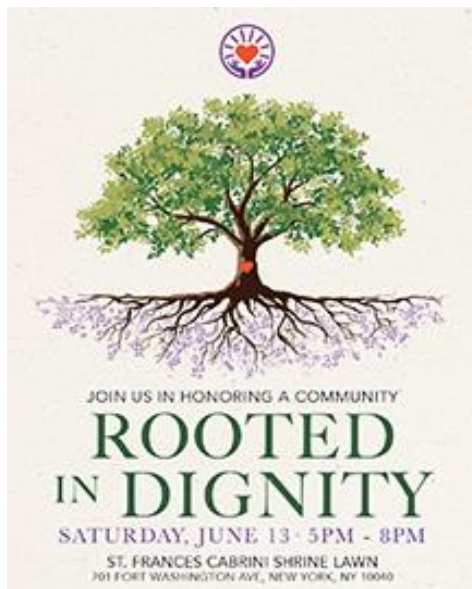
# Creative Mindfulness

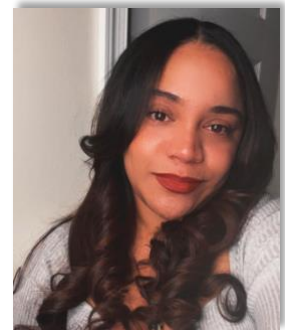
